DECISIONS

NEMO GOVERNANCE

- NEMO Committee re-confirmed the task force leaders until May 2025:
 - Cost TF continues to be led by Martin Vancura, PMO.
 - Governance TF continues to be led by Lajos Valent, OTE.
 - Legal TF continues to be led by Roberto Baldinelli, GME.
 - Technical TF continues to be led by Christoforos Zoumas, HEnEX and newly appointed Chiara Vitelli, GME.
 - R&C TF is led by Yovka Ivanova, IBEX.
- NEMO Committee also plans to re-confirm Rafael Gomez-Elvira as the NEMO Committee Chairman, to be done after the Third Amendment to ANCA has been signed.
- NEMO Committee provided a dedicated position paper to European Commission regarding the expected process on CACM revision and remains open to fully cooperate with the EC in the review process.
- NEMO Committee welcomed two new Observers from Energy Community Contracting Parties – ALPEX (Albania and Kosovo¹) and SEEPEX (Serbia). NEMO Committee also received a request from MEPX/BELLEN (Montenegro), the decision of the Observer status will be made in the next NEMO Committee meeting in July.

MCO INTEGRATION PLAN

- Following the guidance from the European Commission, the submission of the MCO IP is postponed till mid-October. NEMO Committee, together with Energy Community Secretariat are seeking clarification with the EC on the minimum number on designated NEMOs to submit the MCO IP as well as other issues, that may impact the integration of the EnC NEMOs into SDAC and SIDC (e.g. the impact of CBAM).

JOINT GOVERNANCE

- The NEMO vote on the proposed decisions within the agenda of the MCSC meetings was pre-aligned by the All NEMOs Committee, which ensured the efficiency of the MCSC meetings.

CO-OPTIMISATION

- ACER has organised a series of clarification calls to discuss the welfare study with expected outcomes of the co-optimisation and related update of Algorithm methodology. NEMOs experts have participated in the ACER's clarification calls as well as NEMOs have proactively communicated their view on co-

optimisation via position paper to the European Commission and replied to ACER's consultation on the welfare study.

PRODUCT METHODOLOGIES

- NEMO Committee updated the SIDC Product methodology and triggered a public consultation, which will end on 4th July. After that, outcome of the consultation will be taken into account and the updated SIDC Product methodology will be formally submitted to ACER for decision.
- NEMOs experts are also actively participating in ACER's decision process on the SDAC Product methodology.

INTRADAY AUCTIONS

- NEMOs have successfully launched the Intraday Auctions on 13th June, with a delivery on 14th June. NEMO Committee has been regularly updated on the status of the implementation.
- The Aggregated curves for IDAs will be also published on the NEMO Committee website, in the same way as SDAC Aggregated curves.

PROJECT PRIORITISATION

- ACER has gathered all needed information and the final outcome of the prioritisation process was closed at MESC on 13th June.

CACM ANNUAL REPORT FOR 2023

- NEMO Committee has finalised the work on the CACM Annual Report, which was published on 1st July and is also preparing the NEMO Committee Annual Conference, which will be held on 19th September in Athens. The aim of the Conference will be to present the functioning of the SDAC and SIDC in 2023 but also to discuss the future of the markets.
