DECISIONS

NEMO GOVERNANCE

- The main priority of the Q4 was to finalise the **Market Coupling Operation (MCO) Integration Plan**, which summarises the main objectives, conditions and responsibilities for NEMOs/PXs from the Energy Community countries (EnC), which aim to adhere to the SDAC and SIDC.
 - The aim was to finalise and formally submit the MCO IP by 15th December 2023. However, as the implementation of the Energy Community acquis is delayed and therefore no EnC NEMO has been formally designated, European Commission recommended to NEMOs not to formally submit the MCO IP, but wait for EnC NEMOs to be formally designated.
- BRM, a Romanian NEMO, has become a full member of the NEMO Community, by adhering to all NEMO operational contracts. On the other hand, NASDAQ has lost a designation in Sweden and has announced exit from the NEMO Cooperation
- NEMO Committee agreed on the **work programme for 2024** and shared with National Regulators and published it on the NC website.
 - The main priorities are to implement relevant provisions of the Electricity Market Design Reform, be active in the review process of the CACM Regulation and actively assisting with the integration of Energy Community Countries into SDAC and SIDC.
- NEMO Committee finalised and approved the Third Amendment to ANCA, that introduces the possibility of integration of EnC NEMOs and sets forth their voting rights, overall simplifies adherence of new NEMO and clarifies the Chairman election.

JOINT GOVERNANCE

- The NEMO vote on the proposed decisions within the agenda of the MCSC meetings was pre-aligned by the All NEMOs Committee, which ensured the efficiency of the MCSC meetings.

CO-OPTIMISATION

- NEMOs have timely finalised the updated Algorithm methodology and have formally submitted it to ACER for decision.

SDAC PRODUCT METHODOLOGY

- NEMO Committee's Technical group is preparing a consultation on the SDAC Product methodology. The methodology has to be updated due to implementation of 15 min. MTU.

CONSULTATION ON SECOND AUCTION REMOVAL

- NEMOs cooperating within SDAC agreed to hold a consultation on possibility to remove the so-called Second auctions. The consultation expired on 15th January and based on feedbacks from stakeholders, NEMOs will prepare a proposal in this respect.

PROJECT PRIORITISATION

- During the CACM PCG meeting, ACER has raised points related to delays in projects and re-introduced the project prioritisation exercise. However, NEMOs pointed out that the project prioritisation was originally expected as a way to clarify priority points for the future. NEMOs agreed to follow the original idea and aim, together with TSOs, to focus on priority R&D for 2026-2027. A dedicated call was held in January on the level of MESC.

EXTERNAL COMMUNICATION

- NEMO Committee participated in the EC's consultation on Cybersecurity rules as well as in the consultation on Network Code Demand Response. In both cases, NEMO Committee closely cooperated with Europex in preparation of the replies.
- NEMO Committee agreed to extend the information published on NEMO Committee website related to Aggregated curves. The website has been updated accordingly - https://www.nemo-committee.eu/aggregated_curves.
